3 Names: -

The Feast of the Harvest.

Yom Habikkurim (*Numbers 28:26*)

The Day of Firstfruits.

**A) To the Jew – Shavuot is their Wedding Day
in the Lord via The Law.**

**B) To the Messianic Jew and Gentile – Shavuot
or Pentecost is the start of the Church
and the Age or Dispensation of Grace.**

It is one of the 3 mandatory ‘Foot Festivals’.

It is 50 Days after The Feast of Firstfruits.

It is Israel’s 4th Holy Day each year.
